INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

The Community Research Institute at Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne (CRI) has been monitoring business events—expansions, closings, new companies, downsizings, and similar events, since 2008 for the 10-county northeast Indiana area, also known as NEI¹. Since manufacturing has long been a basic sector industry, all changes to manufacturing are monitored, as well as changes in certain industries that have been deemed “core industries” by our economic development agencies. These additional industries include finance and insurance, defense industries, medical devices, logistics and transportation, and food processing. In addition, we monitor the major employers in each of our 10 counties for changes, and any changes to these major employers are also included in this report. The intent continues to be that over time, we should be able to analyze trends, especially concerning our core industries.

CRI employs a certain methodology which dictates that our reporting coincide with activity, rather than an announcement for future plans. That is, if a company announces an expansion, we check for a building permit, tax abatement approval, the addition of equipment, or some evidence of increased employment, and report the activity based on that activity. If there is a multi-year expansion plan, we generally include the data for the planned expansion, but we will revise the data if plans do not materialize as originally intended. There are no changes to the 2009 report. CRI relies heavily on the local economic development officials, the Indiana Economic Development Corporation, and public information. If an event is not made public, it is difficult to incorporate those facts into our reporting. In addition, many companies begin as small entities and grow over time. We would most likely miss the birth of most of these companies. As we stress each year when we prepare this annual summary, this report reflects a small part of all activity; we know we do not have perfect information. The advantage with this report is that it is relatively timely—for example, we will not have comparable government data until eight months into the following year for Bureau of Labor Statistics data, and even later than that for Bureau of Economic Analysis data. Although this report is prepared in the first quarter of the year, CRI and the Regional Partnership have access to the economic pulse of the region at any time due to our diligent monitoring during the entire year. In addition, we monitor by targeted industry which is defined by our region, not by NAICS² codes or industry sectors, and can quickly report what activities are occurring in our core industries at any time.

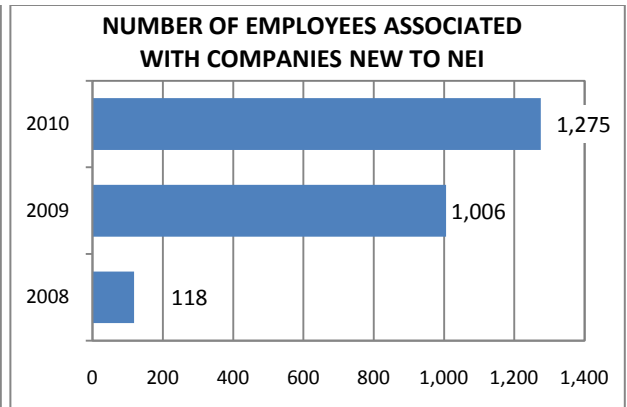
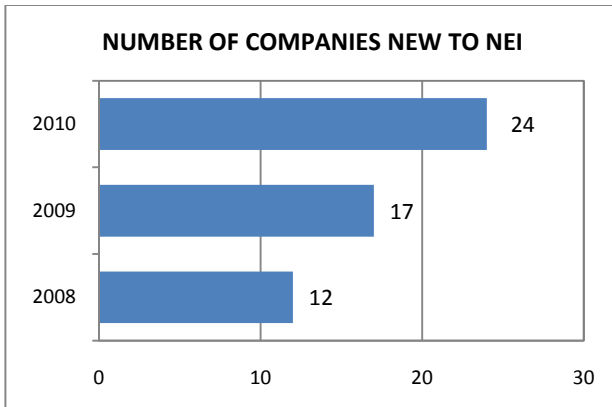
SUMMARY BY THE NUMBERS

Note: This summary is done on a regional “net” basis; that is, there was some activity within the 10-county area involving companies moving from one NEI county into another. On a specific county basis, this is viewed as a specific event, for example, to that county, there is a new company or a closing, but on a regional basis, the effect of these moves is neutral. However, in the activity summaries for each county, each of these intra-NEI moves is reflected in the county totals. There were six intra-NEI moves in 2010, and these are identified in Appendix D.

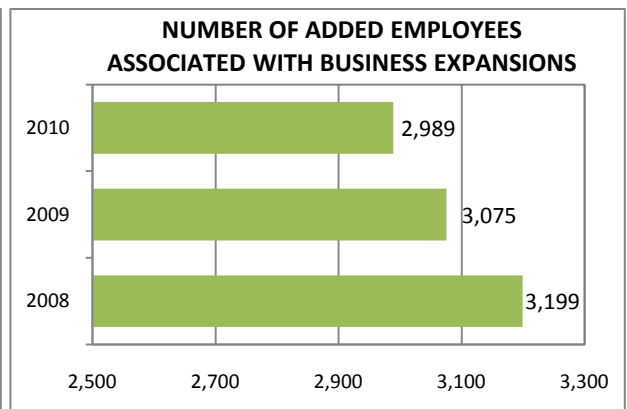
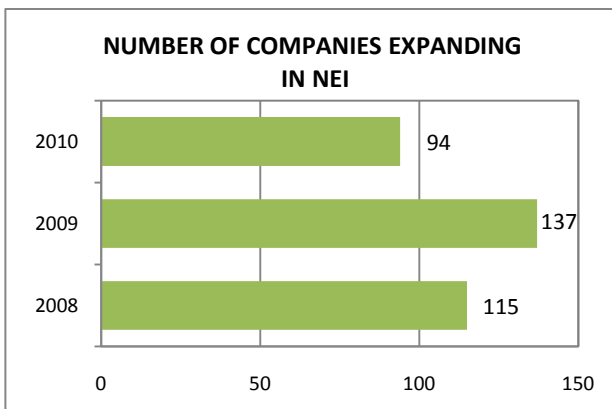
NEW COMPANIES: From a regional perspective, there were 24 net new company announcements in 2010. These 24 new companies brought 1,275 new jobs to NEI.

¹ NEI consists of the following counties: Adams, Allen, DeKalb, Huntington, LaGrange, Noble, Steuben, Wabash, Wells, and Whitley. The population of NEI is approximately 680,000.

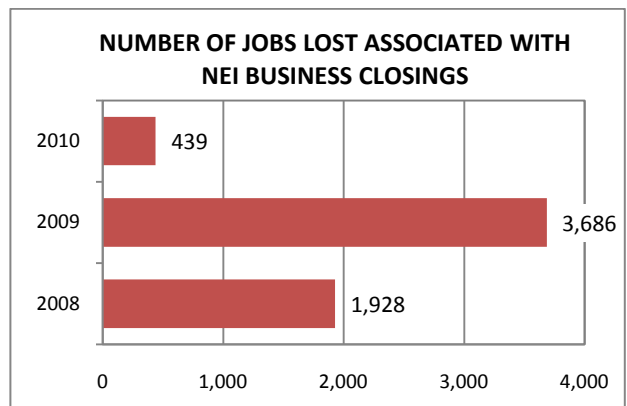
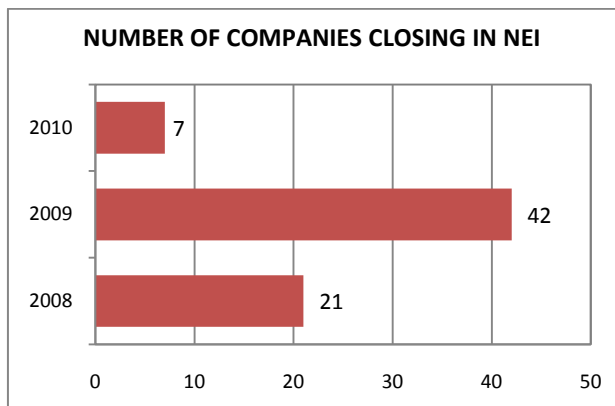

EXPANSIONS: There were 94 company expansions announced in 2010, bringing 2,989 new jobs to NEI. Expansions also counted for \$246 million dollars of space or equipment invested in NEI, and an additional 1.12 million square feet in use. Some companies announced more than one expansion, and these are accounted for as separate events.



CLOSINGS: There were seven net closings announced in 2010, but two of these did not involve loss of jobs because the positions were transferred to other locations within NEI. As a result of the seven closings, 439 people did lose their jobs.



The following categories are also monitored by CRI, although we would be the first to acknowledge that gathering data for downsizings, layoffs, and call-backs carries many unknowns. There are times, however, when this knowledge is helpful or valuable for understanding the local economy. Large layoffs can explain a spike in the unemployment rate, for example.

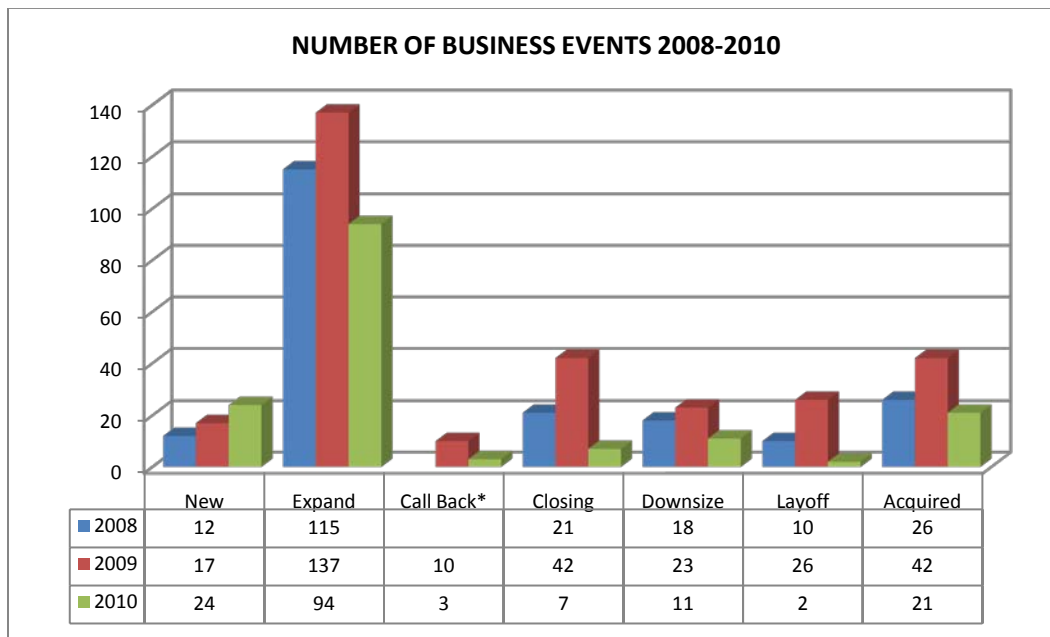
DOWNSIZINGS: There were 11 known downsizings with 735 jobs lost.

LAYOFFS: There were two known layoffs in 2010 which affected 95 jobs, compared to the 26 known layoffs in 2009 which affected over 6,500 jobs. It should be noted that GM had two layoffs in 2009, and their numbers greatly affected this total.

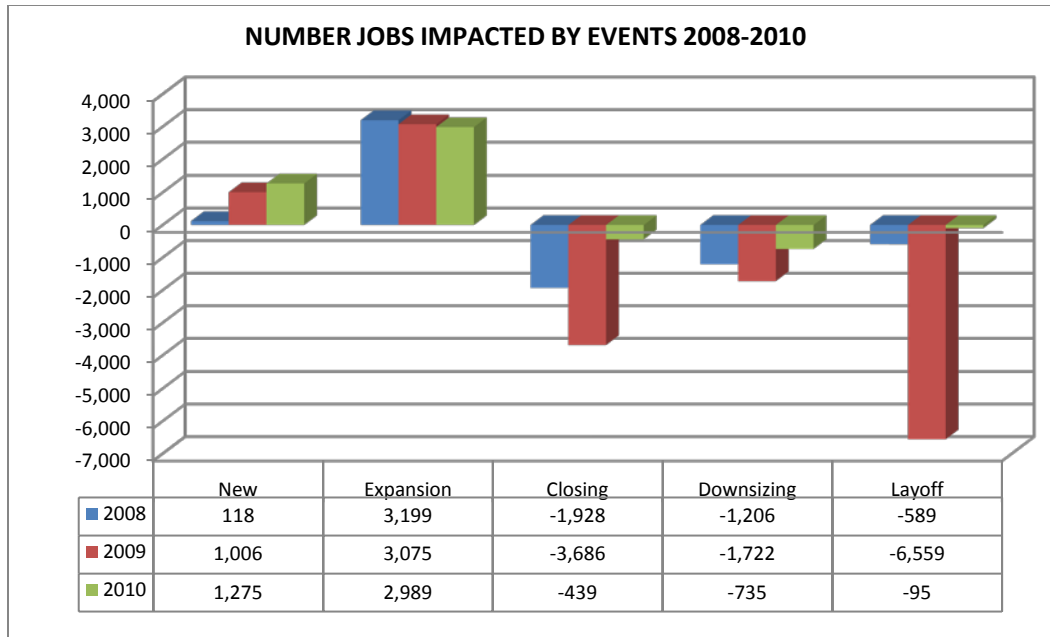
CALL-BACKS: There were three known call-backs which were most likely related to layoffs from prior years. These three call-backs involved 87 positions.

ACQUISITIONS: There were 21 known acquisitions in 2010 in NEI. Acquisitions are monitored because there is some correlation between acquisitions and future closings or changes within the company. For example, Lincoln Foodservice was acquired in 2008 and sold off one of its divisions in 2010. This involved a downsizing in 2010. In 2009, there were 42 known acquisitions and 26 in 2008.

The charts below summarize these events. While NEI is “not out of the woods yet”, our often repeated mantra this year has been “what a difference a year makes!”



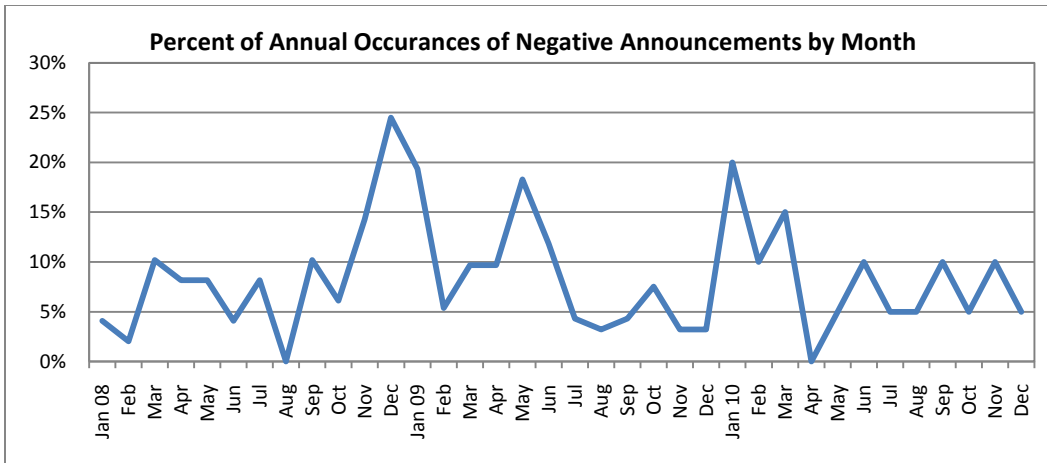

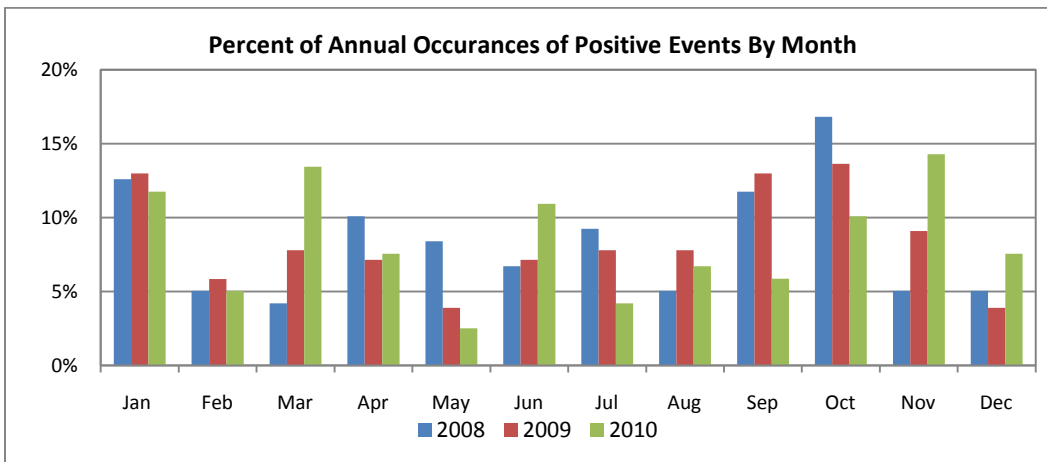
TIME OF YEAR OBSERVATIONS

Although business dynamics events have been tracked in the northeast Indiana region for years, there are some nuances in methodology would make comparisons to years earlier than 2008 not very helpful. For example, while an announcement often coincides with the actual activity, this is not always true, and our methods of recording the events in the month and year in which the event actually occurs are different than what occurred prior to 2008. This means that some analysis of the data is limited to 2008.

NEGATIVE EVENTS: We are not certain if tracking of business events may provide insight whether the time of year is a factor in gauging activity for business events. While time and observations may help tell the story, there has been a monumental recession during this period which most likely skews the data. The chart below identifies the time of year that negative events (closings, downsizings, lay-offs) have occurred. Since there were many more negative events in 2009, this chart reflects the activity as a percent of the total for that year rather than a raw count. The fact that 40 percent of the negative announcements for 2008 occurred in the final three months of that year and that over 60 percent of the 2009 announcements occurred in the first five months demonstrates the effects of the recession. In 2010, the highest percentage of negative events occurred in January.



POSITIVE EVENTS: The monthly trend for positive events (new and expansions) has yet to be firmly established, although it appears that good news occurs more often in January and October, and that February, May, August, and December are “quieter” months.



2010 DETAILS

NEW AND EXPANDING:

There were 94 company expansions announced in 2010, bringing 2,989 new jobs to NEI. Expansions also counted for \$246 million dollars of space or equipment invested in NEI, and an additional 1.12 million square feet in use. Some companies announced more than one expansion, and these are accounted for as separate events. From a regional perspective, there were 24 net new company announcements in 2010. These 24 new companies brought 1,275 new jobs to NEI. This summary does not include intra-NEI moves and expansions, although those events are identified in the county summaries. Intra-NEI moves are also itemized in Appendix D.

Major expansion events included 900 jobs being added to the GM Truck Plant in Allen County. Multimatic Corporation in Butler in DeKalb County plans on increasing their employment number by 209 over a three year period, and Heritage Food Service in Allen County will be adding 150 new jobs. All other expansions were 120

positions or less, although some companies invested heavily in property or equipment. For example, Lutheran Hospital added over \$42 million of capital improvements and over 58,000 square feet to their campus. Living Essential added almost half million square feet to their distribution and manufacturing center in Wabash, as well as increasing their employment by 60 people. Courier Kendallville continued with their expansion which has begun in prior years, adding over 50,000 square feet and over 80 new jobs.

Every county had at least one new business to welcome in 2010. One of the largest was Continental Structural Plastics in Huntington which will employ 350 people with an investment of over nine million in plant and equipment. 175 people will work at Saratoga Potato Chips LLC in Fort Wayne. This company invested almost five million preparing the property and installing the necessary equipment. Iotron Industries Canada had the largest dollar impact for capital and property, investing over 15 million dollars in their new plant in Columbia City. Iotron plans to employ 20.

CLOSINGS AND DOWNSIZINGS:

There were seven net closings in 2010 with 439 jobs lost, but two of these closings did not involve loss of jobs since the positions were transferred to other locations within NEI.

There were 11 known downsizings with 735 jobs lost. Three of these downsizings involve ITT Electronic Systems; that is, at three different times during 2010 ITT announced and enacted downsizings totaling 319 positions. Other major changes occurred at Lincoln Food Service, a manufacturer of food equipment such as specialized ovens and toasters, in which 190 positions were lost, and at Park Center (outpatient mental health care) where 53 positions were eliminated due to a shift in state funding methods for community mental health centers. Lincoln Food Service had been acquired in 2008, and the new management was selling off a division of the business which did not fit with company strategy. Another closing was final chapter of the Fort Wayne Foundry Corp, a long-time NEI business which closed both its Allen and Whitley county locations last year, and then re-opened the Columbia City branch for a short period in 2010.

All in all, though, we repeat our prior statement “what a difference a year makes” as the numbers from 2010 are compared with 2009.

LAYOFFS AND CALL-BACKS:

There were two known layoffs in 2010 which affected 95 jobs. Compare this to the 26 known layoffs in 2009 which affected over 6,500 jobs. This 2009 number included two layoffs by GM which affected over 2,000 people twice in one year, that is, more than 4,000 of the layoffs in 2009 were due to one large employer.

There were three known call backs: Stuart Manufacturing in Allen County, and UT Electronic Controls and Bendix in Huntington. These three called back 87 employees. Stuart had experienced a layoff in the prior year, but our records are incomplete concerning the information on the Huntington companies.

Not all layoffs or call-backs are announced.

ACQUISITIONS:

There were twenty known net NEI acquisitions, plus one other acquisition that involved closing the company in Whitley County and moving it to Allen, increasing the workforce³. CRI monitors acquisitions since often (but not always!) some another activity comes on the heels of the acquisition. By far the largest acquisition in NEI in 2010 was the Frontier Communications Corp buying a segment of the Verizon business. Verizon had over 1200 employees in Allen County. There were also five physicians groups which were acquired by Parkview Health or Lutheran Health or in the case of Indiana Medical Associates, disbanding, with some physicians remaining independent while their former partners joining either Parkview or Lutheran. In these cases, it was anticipated that most of the staff would continue to be employed by the acquiring health company.

Seventeen of the 20 acquisitions, excluding the Precise/Acme acquisition, were in Allen County. There were two in Huntington, and one in DeKalb. In 2009, there were 41 acquisitions and all NEI counties were represented with the exception of LaGrange County. Eighteen of those acquisitions were in Allen County.

TARGETED INDUSTRY REPORTS

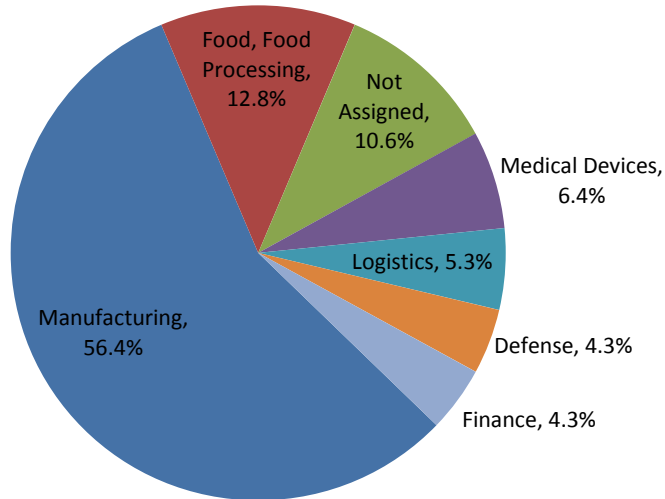
In past years, there has been an attempt to observe whether the changes monitored for the business dynamics report are part of the area's "Targeted Industries". Targeted Industries are loosely defined as specific segments of the economic base in which NEI either has some employment strength or competitive advantage. These include "advanced" manufacturing⁴, logistics/warehousing/transportation, defense, finance and insurance, food manufacturing/processing/related to food processing such as food equipment or food packaging, and medical devices. This part of the report is slightly skewed due to the fact that only certain businesses are monitored for business dynamics reporting-those that are considered major employers in NEI, those in the health field, and those in the targeted industries. That is, changes in retail, lodging, restaurants, and government are not monitored, and construction and education are only included if a specific business is a major employer in one of the NEI counties. Some service sectors are also monitored.

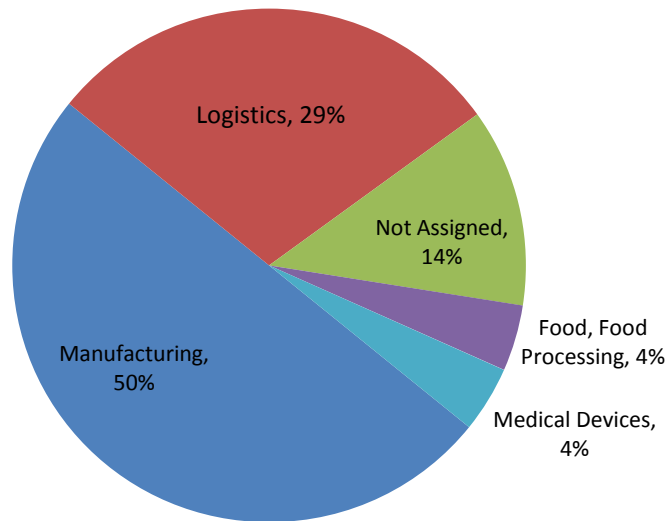
Given that background, it is not unexpected to note that 89.4 percent of expansions monitored for business expansions are in NEI targeted industry groups. (Those not in a targeted industry are shown as “not assigned” in the chart below). Manufacturing remains dominant, both in expansions and as a percent of new companies to the region.

2010 EXPANSIONS BY TARGETED INDUSTRY



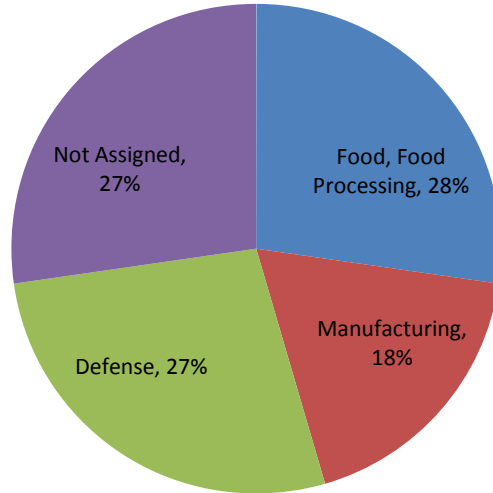
Of the 24 net new companies, 87 percent were classified as being in targeted industries. It is interesting to note that at least four of the seven new Logistics and Transportation companies are geared to food transportation, and that a fifth transportation company is a seed company.

2101 NEW TO NEI BY TARGETED INDUSTRY



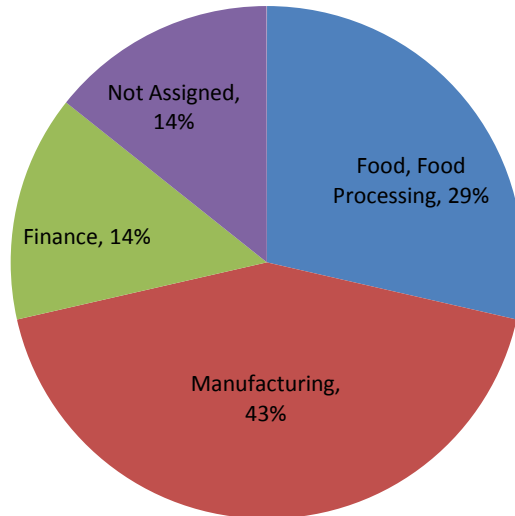
Of the 11 downsizing events, eight were in targeted industries. The three which were not in targeted industries were all outpatient care or health related.

UPCOMING YEAR ANNOUNCEMENTS

As of early February, we are monitoring several events which have been announced for 2011. As of the first week of February 2011, we are aware of six new companies which are slated to open in 2011. Currently, these new companies will be bringing over 700 new jobs. In addition, there are nine expansions known at this time with over 200 jobs. On the negative side, six companies have announced that they will close, and as of this time, we are aware of 137 jobs associated with these closings which will be lost.

APPENDIX C- NAICS CODES

NAICS codes (North American Industry Classification System) are used in classifying business establishments for the purposes of collecting, analyzing, and publishing statistical data related to the U.S. Business economy, and are the standard used by Federal agencies. NAICS is a two-through six-digit hierarchical classification system, with the classification becoming increasingly more detailed as more digits are used. The first 2 digits of the NAICS code identify the economic sector. For example, educational services are in sector 61, health services in 62. The third digit is the subsector; for example 621 is Ambulatory Health Care Service, and the fourth digit designates the industry group. For example, 6213 indicates the Offices of Other Health Practitioners. There are five and six-digit NAICS for more detailed information. In this report, the highest degree of detail is 4-digit NAICS. The following indicate the most common three-digit NAICS used in this report. APPENDIX D- INTRA NEI MOVES

- Therma Tru Distribution
